ADDITIONAL STYLE REQUIREMENTS FOR INSIGHT SUBMISSIONS

LENGTH: It must be between 700 - 900 words.

TITLE: Your submission needs to be accompanied with an engaging title.

REFERENCING:

Articles should not contain any formal academic referencing (bibliographies and footnotes) but should instead use hyperlinks. Please ensure that entire sentences are not hyperlinked, only the relevant subject words. As far as possible, please use references that are free to access (no paywalled newspaper or journal articles).

IMAGE:

Please attach a preferred image to be published alongside your article. Please ensure that it is high-quality, landscape, and licensed for reuse under a Creative Commons licence (providing full attribution and a hyperlink to the original source).

AUTHOR BIOGRAPHY:

Include a two-line biography to be published alongside your work with your relevant academic and professional details.

SUBJECT MATTER:

We publish articles on a range of topics related to international relations. These include, but are certainly not limited to: geopolitics, climate change, technology and cyber, cultural diplomacy, social movements, the economy, and multilateral engagement.
